



Training Workshop on scientific research: from bibliographic research to scientific writing

Objectives

This workshop aims to present to the young doctoral students the principles of scientific research, the fundamental definitions and the purpose of the research, why conducting a research, why is it necessary, what are the different objectives? understanding our environment, personal and social orientation, innovation ...). It is also a question of highlighting the context and the specificities of the development of scientific research in developing countries such as Algeria, notably in terms of the research environment and relations with the socio-economic sectors for the valorization of research. research and contribution to the development of the country. The organization of a three-day training workshop on bibliographic research, reading and scientific writing techniques aims to contribute to the training of PhD students in the practice of scientific research, research methods, training tools and scientific research, writing and communication.

The training workshop is intended for new PhD students from research laboratories of different departments of the Faculty of Technology at Blida University 1. It remains open to PhD students from other faculties depending on availability of seats. Students who have already benefited from this training previously are not allowed to take part in this session.

Workshop Thematics

A - Initiation of research topics: role of the researcher (doctoral student, supervisor, manager, ...), of his community (research environment), public authorities, companies, institutions, associations, etc.

B - Techniques of research: formulation of an issue, bibliography, methodology, writing. Applied exercises with concrete examples.

C - Dissemination of research results: which audiences, which methods; open knowledge and closed knowledge. Writing of research reports, thesis, publication and communication.
